**Care and Use Instructions
For Mincey Marble Cast Marble Products with a
MATTE FINISH**

Each Mincey Marble product is handcrafted and custom-made. They excel in beauty, durability and stain resistance. With proper care our products will remain as beautiful and elegant as the day they were installed.

NORMAL CLEANING:

Mincey surfaces are non-porous, meaning they are sealed, so they may be easily wiped clean. An ammonia-based cleaner such as Windex™ or Glass Plus™ will work well for routine cleaning. On stubborn stains and cigarette burns, you may want to use an abrasive cleanser. To keep your finish looking like new, occasionally rub your matte finished product with a Scotch-Brite™ pad alone.

REPAIRING SCRATCHES:

Mincey's matte finish is typically finished to a 320-350 grit wet sanding level. For minor scratches, use a Scotch-Brite™ pad with an abrasive cleaner. Clean thoroughly with soap and water and let dry. For deeper scratches, carefully sand with 320 grit wet sandpaper. To restore the finish, use an abrasive cleanser and a Scotch-Brite pad, cleaning thoroughly with soap and water when finished.

PREVENTING DAMAGE TO MINCEY MARBLE PRODUCTS:

1. Mincey's products are extremely stain-resistant and durable, however, some strong chemicals such as stain removers, drain cleaners, nail polish removers (acetone), chlorine bleach, hair color and other strong acidic liquids can damage the surface if left standing. If these spills occur, flush the surface with soapy water and then clean as normal.
2. Do not permit heavy or pointed objects to strike the surface of the product. If this does occur, repair kits are available.

3. Although Mincey Marble withstands heat extremely well, and cigarette burns are easily removed, do not place hot irons, curling irons, cigarettes etc, on the surface of the marble. This could cause damage deep enough to require a professional refinisher.
4. Mincey Marble products are not to be used as a "cutting board". Minor scratches may be easily repaired, but deep cuts will require a professional refinisher.
